Trade Summary - Painters work on a variety of structures, from bridges to the interiors and exteriors of buildings, and they typically work both indoors and outdoors. Painting requires a lot of bending, kneeling, reaching, and climbing. Those who paint bridges or buildings may be exposed to extreme heights and uncomfortable positions; some painters are suspended by ropes or cables as they work.

Painters work both indoors and out. Outside work is done in relatively mild weather. Work is seasonal; however, new materials and methods tend to give more steady employment throughout the year. The work involves standing, bending, climbing and working with arms over the head most of the time.
