Trade Summary - Plasterers-work on a variety of commercial and residential construction projects. They do many types of work, including; exterior finish systems, restoration work, cornice/ornamental plastering, plaster mold making, modern veneer, hard coat applications, sculpturing, molding work, swimming pool surface application, decorative venetian plaster work, cement stucco, and spray on fireproofing.

Plasterers typically work indoors involving reaching, bending and kneeling requiring endurance but not exceptional strength.
