



Sprinkler Fitters

Trade Summary - Sprinkler fitters are pipe fitting specialists in fire protection. They install, repair, and maintain all types of fixed extinguishing systems. While most work deals directly with automatic sprinkler systems, they also have the skills necessary to install and service a wide variety of other fire protection equipment, such as standpipes, carbon dioxide systems, halon systems, foam systems, and dry chemical systems.

Sprinkler Fitters work can be physically demanding because it involves heavy lifting, bending, kneeling, as well as possibly working in a trench 8 feet below ground or working 100 feet or higher above the ground. Sprinkler Fitters work both indoors and outdoors in very hot or very cold weather. Sprinkler Fitters need to manage heavy equipment and lift loads in excess of 100 lbs. since Sprinkler Fitters work in narrow spaces on ladders and high scaffolding.
