



# CRAFT LABORERS (CCL)

## TRADE SUMMARY

Construction Craft Laborers (CCL) must have knowledge of all the work performed on heavy highway projects, environmental projects, and building trades projects. CCLs are usually the first trade on most projects and the last trade at the conclusion of most projects. CCLs are called upon to operate and maintain power tools, such as chain saws, compaction equipment, concrete vibrators, pavement breakers, chipping hammers, cutting, and burning torches, demolition equipment, and they assist with use of explosives. CCLs also mix materials for bricklayers and plasterers. CCL set grade, stringline, work with GPS equipment, install sewers and water main, and help set up cranes and lifting equipment with cribbage and matting.

# WHAT TO ANTICIPATE

Laborers are exposed to all weather conditions. Sometimes they are called upon to work at heights and depths, sometimes hundreds of feet underground on subways, tunnels and storage reservoirs. In their work, there is much bending, walking, standing, lifting and carrying.
